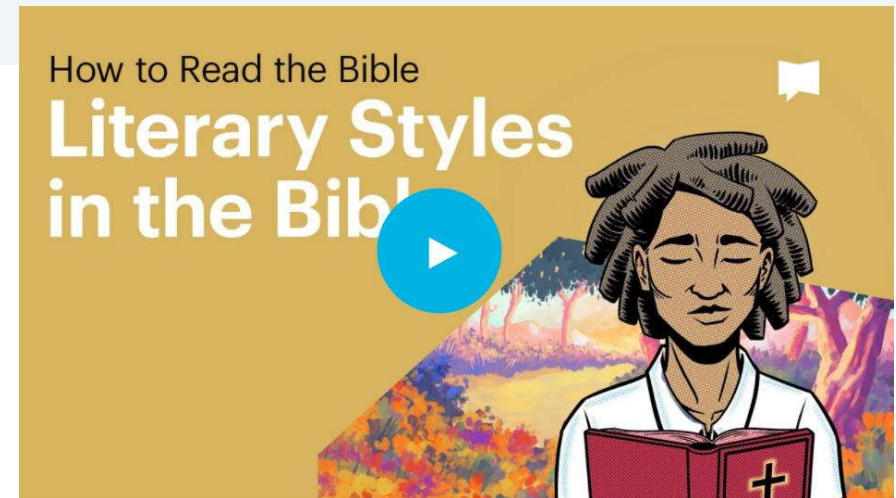


## A THOUGHT FOR SUNDAY
