FRIENDS OF ALL SAINTS AGM

The Friends of All Saints AGM will be held on Wednesday the 12th of May at 8 pm virtually over Zoom.

This year, we need your help as, under our constitutional rules, committee members who have served for 3 years need to be re-elected. This year we have 3 members in that position and none of them are re-standing. Along with that we also have another committee member who is standing down having served on the committee for many years. This leaves us in an exceedingly difficult position needing to replace 4 committee members.

We desperately need your help. If we do not have people step forward, we will struggle to have sufficient members to function as we will be below the minimum number of 6 required by the constitution. Therefore, I strongly urge you to consider joining the committee to help us move forward and continue our vital support to the PCC in maintaining the fabric of the church.

At this time of Covid, we are not busy planning or running events, but hopefully we will return to that later in the year and will need committee members to organise and run these events. We are looking both for people to join as organisers and/or helpers at events and also for people willing to hold the key positions within the committee.

As we do every year after the AGM, we will be looking to appoint from within the committee, a Chairman, a Treasurer and Secretary, so if you have previous experience in any of these roles in your working or charity life those skills would be very welcome.

If you feel that you can bring some new ideas or existing skills to the committee, then we would love to hear from you. Anyone putting themselves forward will need to be a member of the Friends, but it is simple to join with a minimum annual £5 membership fee. There is time to join before and be elected at the AGM on the 12th May if you are not a current member.
