CHURCH CLEANING

OPENING AND MANAGING CHURCH BUILDINGS IN STEP 4 IN THE ROAD MAP OUT OF LOCKDOWN

Government guidance continues to remind us that increased frequency of cleaning of general room surfaces reduces the presence of the virus and the risk of contact transmission.

What sort of cleaning should we be doing?

Frequently touched surfaces and well used areas should still be regularly cleaned.

The guidance continues with pointing out that life event services such as weddings, baptisms and funerals can be some of the most important pastoral encounters in a Parish and in the life of a family but also may cause particular challenges as we move to Step 4 of the Government's road map.

In order to help families have a good experience, we have a duty of care by keeping our Church clean. At these life events, people come from all different areas of the country with high or lower infection rates – we don't know – but potentially are a risk for transmission. Therefore, guidance clearly advises the cleaning of the Church after those events and Sunday services; wherever there is a larger number of people.

At the moment the level of cleanliness in our Church is not fit for purpose. It requires a thorough clean from bat droppings, pews need to be soaked down and carpets need serious cleaning.

Therefore, I will be in Church from Tuesday to Thursday from 11.00am and start with deep cleaning the Church. Julia will join me when she can and may I ask for anybody able to give an hour or so to help me with that. Val and I will clean after weddings and funerals. I shall clean after baptisms and I would like anybody willing to help wiping used pews after the Sunday Service.

I would like to thank all Holy Dusters who have regularly cleaned the Church throughout the pandemic so far, but unfortunately our head of Holy Dusters has decided regular cleaning is not required now and has therefore resigned from her post.

As already mentioned we are required to keep the risk of infection to a minimum and so I appeal to all that may be able to help with the cleaning going forward.
