BIBLICAL STUDIES

From Revd. Canon Professor Richard Burridge:

"I am delighted to announce the London première and first live performance of the whole of the Gospel According to St Mark in my new translation.

It will take place live in person in St Luke's Church, West Holloway, Hilmarton Rd, London, N7 on Friday October 8th 7.30-10pm, but it will also be simultaneously live-streamed online for a wider, even international, audience.

Live tickets at the door £10 (concessions £7.50), with all profits split between St Luke's Church and supporting the important work of the Amos Trust operating in the holy land of Jesus. To reserve a seat in church in advance, or for log-in details for the online live-stream (also online donations welcome, please email or message me - details attached."

The Revd Canon Professor Richard A. Burridge is an internationally recognised biblical scholar, ethicist, theologian and social commentator. During his career, he has been a schoolmaster, parish priest, university chaplain, academic, and professor, and he served as Dean of King's College London for over 25 years from 1993 to 2019. He is the author of several books, including the ground breaking *What are the Gospels?* He was awarded the 2013 Ratzinger Prize by Pope Francis, the first non-Roman Catholic to receive this prize for academic scholarship.
