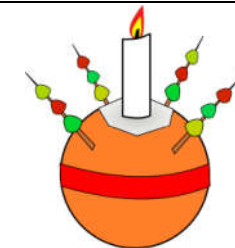
### BABY BOOK

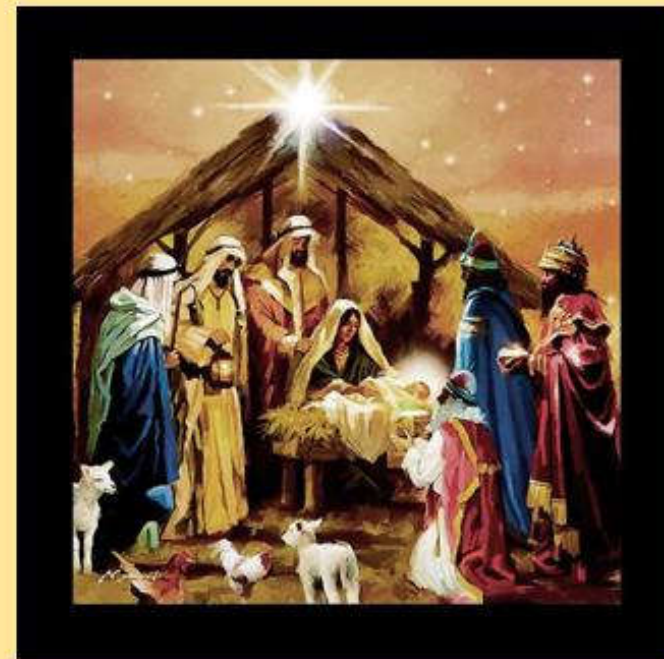
