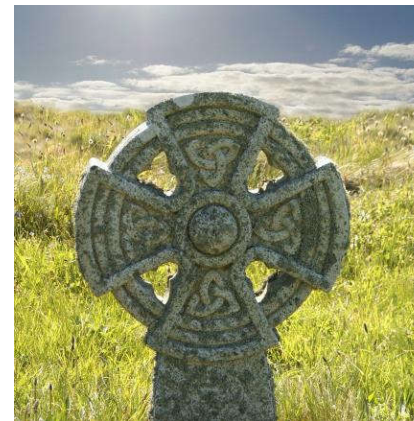
Tickets are just £10 to include delicious canapés, and there will be a licensed bar all evening serving wine and soft drinks.

## ORDINATION OF ANDREW EDWARDS 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2022

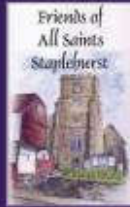
Thank you to Rev Silke and everyone at All Saints Church for being part of
