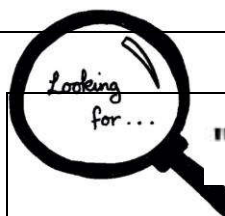

## ALL SAINTS TOWER TURRET RESTORATION

### GREAT NEWS:



Thanks to the generosity of the village community and a number of grant giving bodies, together with a lot of money from the Friends of All Saints, we now have raised 90% of the funds required to complete the restoration work.

The PCC has been reassured that the work can go ahead as a contingency fund had been calculated into the amount estimated for the work and also that the Friends would cover further costs. On those terms the PCC agreed for the work to start as soon as possible in order for it to be completed this summer (text adapted).

As there is an outstanding 10% still to be raised, our fund-raising efforts continue as we still need several thousand pounds, but we do hope to see the scaffolding going up in a few weeks' time.

The work will restore the timbers of the turret roof and its small spire and weathervane, the decaying stonework of the turret including the broken door lintel which holds up the spire, and the tower roof itself. Although the work is critical to the safety of the turret of this grade 1 listed building, we receive no support from the wider church organisation.
