TOWER TURRET RESTORATION UPDATE

TOWER TURRET WORKS

We are pleased to announce that we have now received dates from the contractors for the commencement of the restoration of the tower turret:

Contract start date: Monday 8th July 2024

Contract completion date: Friday 11th October 2024

FUNDING UPDATE

Unfortunately the price has increased by another £2000 because of the cost of the lead and the lead workers fee.

Our fund-raising efforts therefore continue as we still need several thousand pounds to reach our target.

The work will restore the timbers of the turret roof and its small spire and weathervane, the decaying stonework of the turret including the broken door lintel which holds up the spire, and the tower roof itself. Although the work is critical to the safety of the turret of this grade 1 listed building, we receive no support from the wider church organisation.

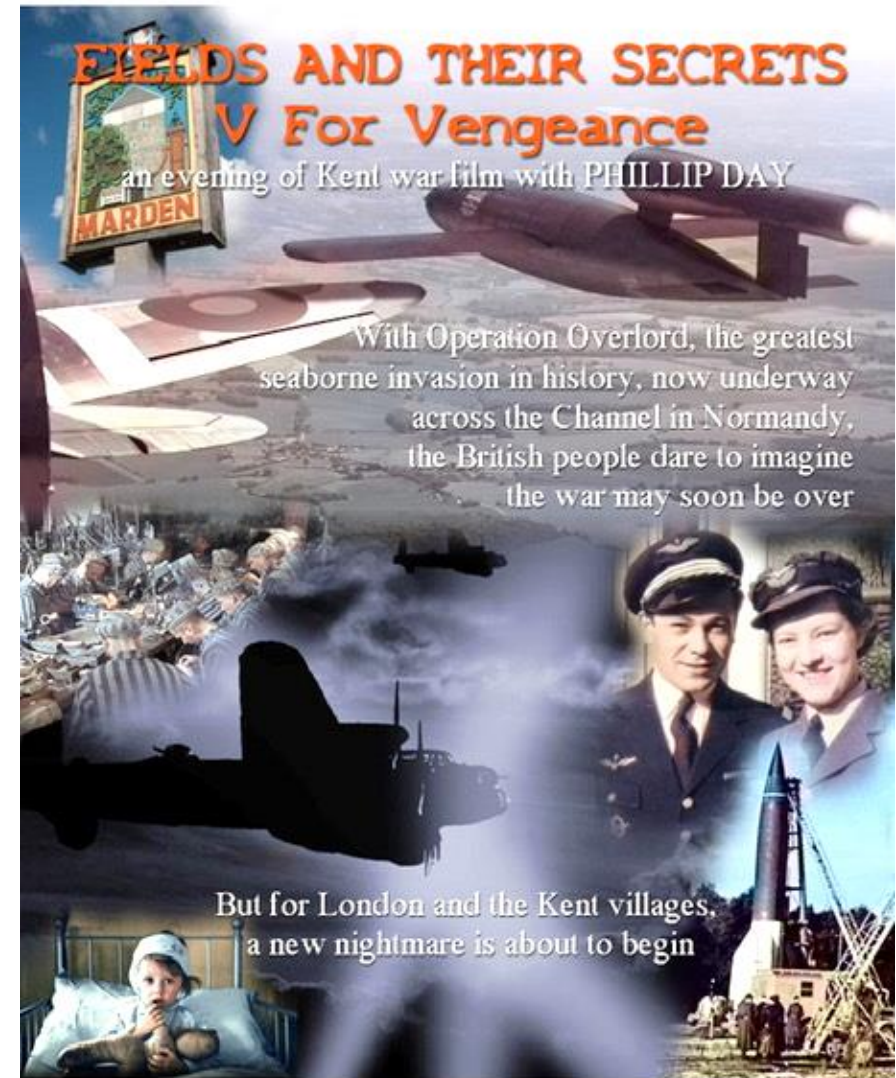
If you can, please help us to save this 12th century iconic building:
