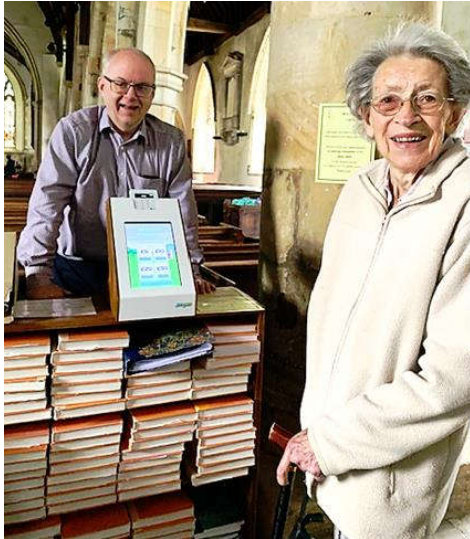

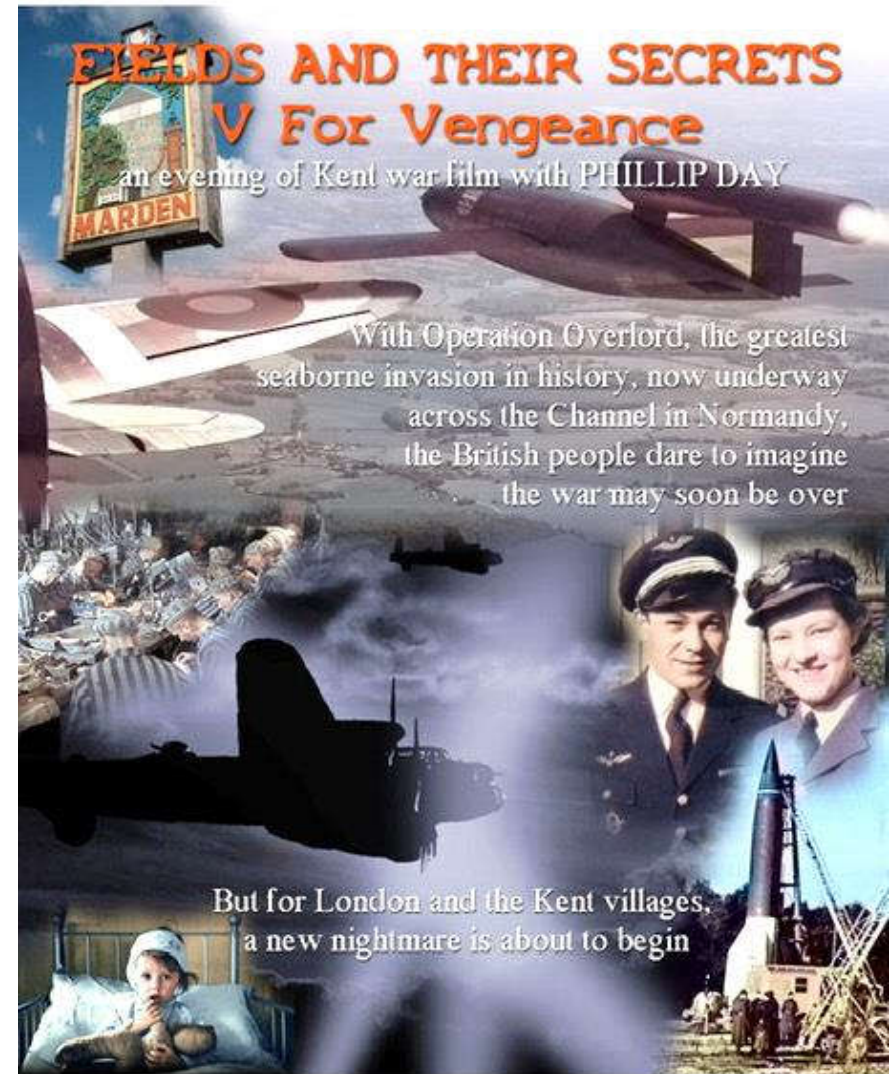
A THANK YOU FROM MONICA
