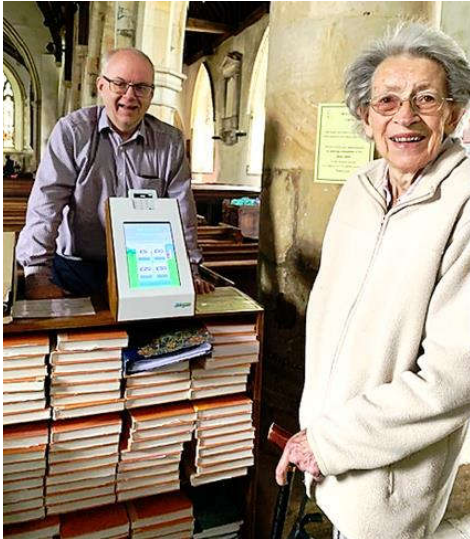

It is only thanks due to a very small number of volunteers that we have been able to carry out the minimum tasks that need attention; we are extremely thankful for all they do!

A big Volunteer Day, like the one that we are planning, will leave our village ready for the summer.

In the past, big numbers of volunteers have helped in some big projects: together we have had many village clean ups, together we painted the library, we got rid of the jungle that was the big planters at the Parade, we organised two collections for Ukraine, and together we assisted many vulnerable residents during Covid. We want to do it again and we need your help.

We will organise the volunteers in to teams and we will give them specific tasks to carry out. We have the jobs and the experience. Please, turn up with a pair of gloves and a tool or two of your choice.

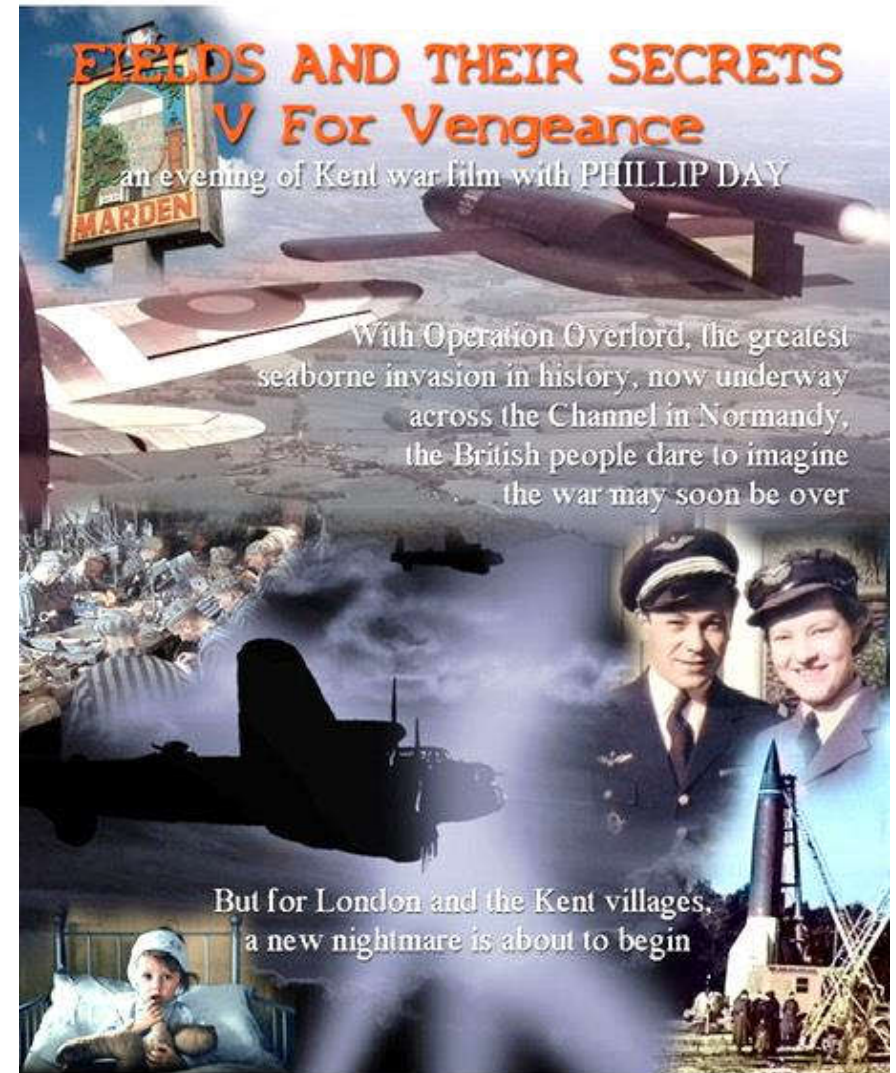
