CHURCHYARD BINS

PLEASE NOTE

The new waste management policy and procedure has been implemented in the Churchyard.

The changes are: the existing fixed rubbish bins will no longer be in use and will be removed in the near future. With only very few volunteers, it was a struggle to keep up with the amount of rubbish people squeezed into the bins that, before disposing of, needed separating out.

To streamline waste disposal, three large wheelie bins have been strategically placed throughout the churchyard. The bins and their respective purposes are:

BLACK BIN: for general rubbish and dog waste

GREEN BIN: for recyclable materials such as tins, cans, and cardboard **BROWN BIN**: for garden waste, including dead flowers and weeds

Please be mindful to utilise the appropriate bin for your rubbish to facilitate the process.

Please note the designated locations of the wheelie bins and refrain from moving them:

- The **BLACK** and **GREEN** bins are located near the east end of the church, next to the path leading to the back gate
- The **BROWN** bin can be found down the path towards the New Churchyard

While professionals handle grass cutting and tree maintenance, it lies with all of us to volunteer to wheel the bins to the roadside for the Monday collection.

We are appealing for all able bodied assistance in maintaining the cleanliness of the churchyard which would be greatly appreciated. If you feel that you could help there is a list at the back of Church to initially indicate you are willing to help.


If you are unable to fill a box but would like to contribute, suitable items would be very much appreciated as would any monetary donations, and I can then complete a box on your behalf
