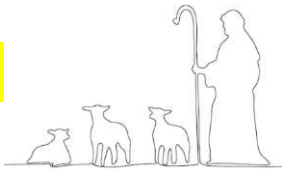

I also need to dress a shepherd who will be 42inches tall so in need of larger pieces of material, also some felt, in a variety of colours.

The Shepherd will be looking after the sheep.
