Donations may be given in:

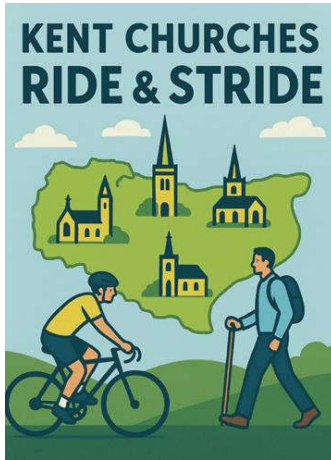
1. An orange monthly charity envelope. Get your year's supply from Tony Henley.

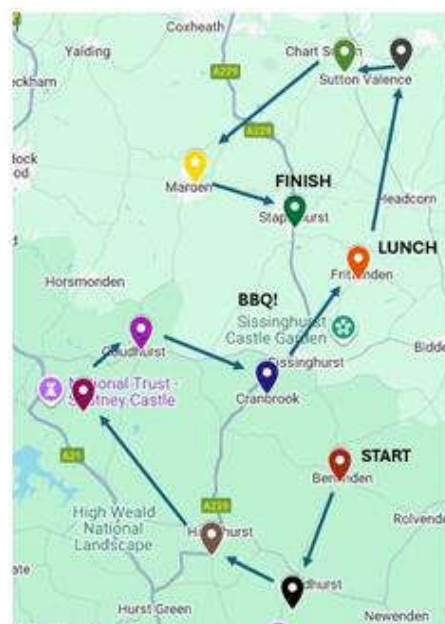
Peter's last day in office will be 9 November 2025.
