A season to give an especial, prayerful focus to Safeguarding within the Church of England and beyond.

Loving God, we pray that this church may be a place of welcome, security and compassion. Keep us watchful yet caring, trusting yet ready to question, that all who worship here may do so in safety and in the knowledge of your love; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

We should all grieve abuse anywhere, and especially within the organisation of the church: part of the liturgy planned for Canterbury Cathedral is a Service of Lament. We pray for victims and survivors who have suffered at the hands of abusers and that they may be able to move towards rebuilding their lives. Within our All Saints' community, those who take on roles of leadership of church activities and involvement with children, young people and vulnerable adults have completed the necessary training, and it is encouraging to see an awareness of safeguarding concerns permeating the organisation and arrangement of church activities. Thank you.

Safeguarding is the responsibility of us all, as we follow Christ's example to give dignity and care to all. Safeguarding posters will be on display at the back of church: please take a few moments to look at them and challenge yourself with the statements and questions they pose.

Prayers at the 10am service on November 16th will be for Safeguarding. Prayer cards will also be available in St George's chapel and on the coffee tables.

"He calls his own sheep by name". John 10 v3.


