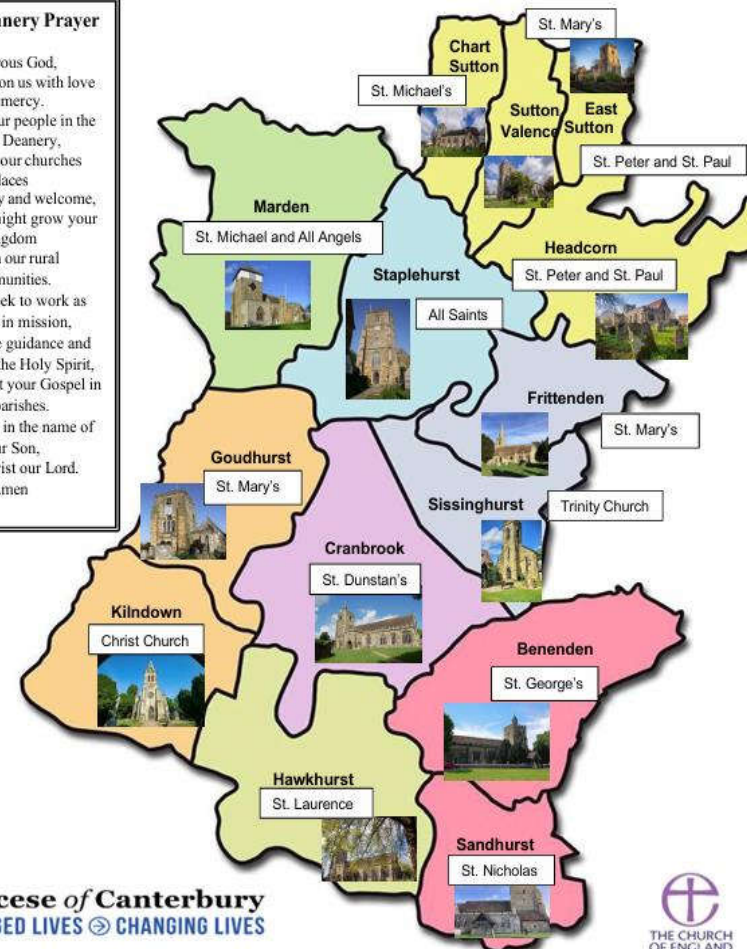

## COFFEE MORNING

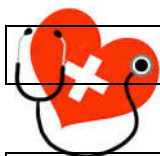

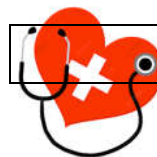


## STAPLEHURST HEALTH CENTER NEWS

A few highlights from the recent Patient Participation Group meeting:

### SUPPORTING OLDER AND VULNERABLE PATIENTS

The surgery is involved in a new Winter Frailty Programme, helping those who are frail or receiving palliative care to plan ahead and stay well. Part of this includes the *ReSPECT* plan, which allows patients to record their wishes for emergency care.
