



## VISIT TO ST. PETERS CHURCH



The Millennium Window at St Peter's Church in Boughton Monchelsea is a distinctive modern artwork created to mark the arrival of the year 2000. Installed on the south wall of the tower, it was designed not only as a stained-glass feature but also as a functional screen between the vestry and the tower. The idea originated when the church planned renovations that required covering an interior glass opening; the vicar and architect invited local artist Graham Clarke to design a piece that would be both beautiful and practical. The result is a unique window incorporating sound and lighting elements, intended to be experienced as much as viewed, and now stands as one of the church's most notable contemporary additions.

## Notices in the Churchyard – Please Read




From March onwards, you will see small printed notices placed on certain graves in the churchyard. These notices will appear where items or planting do not comply with the Churchyard Regulations, especially in areas set aside for wildlife conservation.

Some parts of the churchyard are carefully managed to protect wildflowers, insects, and the wider biodiversity that has developed over many years. The turf in these areas is not ordinary grass, and digging, planting, edging, or placing objects can unintentionally harm this delicate habitat. Certain items may also create safety risks for visitors, volunteers, and those who help maintain the churchyard.

The notice is not intended to cause offence or upset. Its purpose is simply to explain the situation and to invite families or representatives to remove any items that fall outside the regulations agreed at the time of interment.

If no action is taken, the church will remove items in accordance with the Churchyard Regulations, though we always hope matters can be resolved cooperatively and with understanding. The full Churchyard Regulations are available in the church porch and online (Canterbury Diocesan Churchyard regulations 2025 (amended memorial plaques 2022)). If you have any questions or concerns, please speak to a churchwarden or contact the parish office on 01580891258.

Thank you for helping us care for the churchyard as a place of remembrance, peace, and shared responsibility.



## Invitation to Confirmation

Life fills up quickly, school, work, friendships, responsibilities, all the things that keep you moving from one moment to the next. In the middle of it, it's easy for certain intentions or questions to fade into the background, including the idea of being confirmed. Maybe you thought about it once, maybe you assumed it wasn't for you, or maybe life simply carried you in other directions.

But every so often, something prompts you to think about what really matters, who you're becoming, what you believe, and what kind of foundation you want for your life. Those moments have a way of opening our eyes to the deeper parts of ourselves that don't always get attention in the everyday rush.

If you've ever felt even a small nudge toward faith, or wondered about taking a step you thought you'd missed, consider this a gentle reminder that it's never too late. Confirmation isn't about having everything figured out. It's not about being perfect or knowing all the answers. It's an opportunity to explore, to ask questions, to reconnect with something meaningful, and to discover how faith might speak into your life today.

If something in you is curious, even quietly, you're warmly invited to take that next step. No pressure, no expectations. Just an open door and a community ready to walk with you as you explore what this could mean for you.

The next Deanery Confirmation will be on Sunday 31st May 2026, 3.00pm at St. Michael's & All Angels Church in Marden led by Bishop Rose. Each candidate will feel the profound significance of these words as the bishop lays hands on them: "*God has called you by name and made you His own. Confirm, O Lord, your servant with your Holy Spirit.*"
