A new Archbishop and Bishop of Canterbury

Bishop Sarah Mullally DBE has been confirmed as the 106th Archbishop of Canterbury—the first woman to hold the role in its 1,400-year history. The Confirmation of Election took place at St Paul's Cathedral, where she also legally became Bishop of the Diocese of Canterbury. Representatives from our diocese took part in the service, and her name has now been inscribed in Canterbury Cathedral alongside her predecessors.

The service included prayers, a Charge from voices across the Church of England and Anglican Communion, and joyful celebrations led by Bishop Rose Hudson-Wilkin. An Installation service will follow at Canterbury Cathedral on **25 March**, when Archbishop Sarah will preach her first sermon in the role.

In the weeks ahead, she will pay homage to The King, meet leaders of other Christian traditions and faiths, and co-preserve at General Synod. Archbishop Sarah has spoken of her commitment to guiding the Church with “calmness, consistency and compassion,” and to ensuring it is a safe, welcoming place for all, especially the vulnerable.

VISIT TO ST. PETERS CHURCH



The Millennium Window at St Peter's Church in Boughton Monchelsea is a distinctive modern artwork created to mark the arrival of the year 2000. Installed on the south wall of the tower, it was designed not only as a stained-glass feature but also as a functional screen between the vestry and the tower. The idea originated when the church planned renovations that required covering an interior glass opening; the vicar and architect invited local artist Graham Clarke to design a piece

that would be both beautiful and practical. The result is a unique window incorporating sound and lighting elements, intended to be experienced as much as viewed, and now stands as one of the church's most notable contemporary additions.
