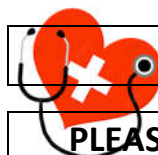

KEEPING THE CHURCH COOL & DRY IN SUMMER

Could everyone, where possible, keep enough doors closed to minimise warm, moist air entering the church.

Although the outside air may not seem particularly humid, warm air carries much more moisture than cool air. When it enters the cooler church, the relative humidity increases and moisture can condense on the fabric of the building, increasing the risk of mould and damage.

Keeping the church cool also allows it to remain a welcome cool space for the village during periods of hot weather.

We appreciate that it is pleasant to have the south door open, but from the perspective of caring for our historic building, it is generally better to keep it closed unless there is a particular reason to have it open.
